You must complete an entry form for each entry

When preparing your entry please ensure:

- All bottles must be cleaned and sanitised. This can be achieved by cleaning the bottles with hot soapy water, then applying a food grade sanitiser.
- Hands must be washed regularly with soap and dried with paper towel.
- All bottles must be closed tightly.
- Please observe best food handling practices when preparing your entry. Guidelines available here: www2.health.vic.gov.au/public-health/food-safety
- Entrants in beer and wine categories must be available to attend and offer tastings to patrons at the 'Meet the Makers Showcase' on Saturday 8 June 1 – 4pm at Northcote Town Hall. We recommend entrants bring at least 6 bottles of each entry to offer as tastings on the day.
- All category entrants will receive an invitation to attend an awards ceremony held on Friday 7 June at the Preston City Hall 6pm – 8pm where winners will be announced and prizes awarded.

- The People's Choice Award will awarded as usual at the 'Meet the Makers showcase' on Saturday 8 June.
- Passata, Preserved Olives and Pickled Vegetables entrants do not offer tastings.
- Entrants must live, work, study or recreate in the City of Darebin.
