n-SCRIBE 2020 SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Please make sure your name is **not** on submitted work. We use a blind submission process. If your name is on your uploaded writing, it will be disqualified.

Experimentation with language and dialect is supported.

Submissions are welcome in any language however, we ask that you include an English translation of your work to assist the working group. This can be in your own words.

The submitted work must not have been published or accepted for publication by any publisher including online publications.

Your writing must be typed, double-spaced, in a legible size 11 or 12 font.

Each page must be numbered and include the title.

Only doc docx and pdf files can be accepted. No Apple pages, ipad documents, or photos can be accepted.

1200 word limit on submissions.

Please name your file using this format: **[title of your work].file type** e.g. **To the Lighthouse.docx**

Writers must have a connection to Darebin i.e. live, work or study in the City of Darebin. We understand that some of these connections have changed as a result of COVID-19.

Maximum 2 submissions per person

The selection of works is done by the working group. The Working Group's decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into.

Submissions can only be accepted via the [online submission portal](#). No hard copies or emailed writing can be accepted.

You must be over 18 years to submit
